Option A: Please choose a bylaw that is already mandated in Calgary that you <u>do not</u> agree with. Rework the bylaw so that it makes more sense for you.

Option B: Create a new bylaw that is NOT already mandated for our city.

Answer the following questions that can be handed in with your assignment.

Bylaws

- Why do local governments pass by laws? (What is the purpose of them?)
- What would happen if the rules were set by Provincial of Federal Government's?
- What would happen if there were no bylaws? Refer to FREJ.
- In what ways do bylaws show justice?
- Explain and describe a few bylaws that have been passed that you agree/disagree with. Explain why you agree or why you disagree.
- If you wanted to change a bylaw what process would you take?

The presentation method for this assignment is up to you, however it is essential that you deliver your information to the class in a way that is more exciting than a powerpoint.

Step by Step

- 1. You will need to research current bylaws in Calgary, find one you would like to change or one you would like to create. It MUST be reasonable and not contradict another bylaw currently.
- 2. You will need to create a survey to poll others around you if the majority of people do not agree with your bylaw it would not pass city council.
- Your survey will explain the new or created bylaw and the recipient should be able to agree or disagree.
- 3. The presentation piece should be no longer than 5 minutes and needs to clearly identify the bylaw and the results of the survey.
- 4. The 6 questions need to be clearly explained using your own words, written neatly or typed and handed in before you may present your bylaw. (Textbook pages to Help (198, 199, 221,228-231)
